### **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

Pastor Ben continued in the series "Fix This" as he talked about compatilibity, faith and the future and the importance of being on the same page.

## Read 1 Corinthians 13:4-7

What do you notice about the way "love" is described in these verses?

Pastor Ben started by stating that most operate by "default" rather than by "design"? Do you agree or disagree? If you're in a relationship, how do you operate as a couple?

# Read Ephesians 4:31.

"Uniqueness + Togetherness = Oneness" is a formula for how this works in our lives. Do you see this in your relationship? Or what's a relationship where you have seen this actually happen?

What are some ways you work to be "on the same page" with your partner?

Pastor Ben shared five ways to be closer based on Ephesians 4 and 5.

1. Decide how big God is going to be in your home.

Read Ephesians 5:1. How does God's love for you affect the way you love in your relationships with others?

2. Get tools and a team to grow your marriage.

What are some of your best tools and teams that have helped you grow your marriage?

3. Discover their needs and priorities.

What are some needs and priorities of your significant other? How do you honor them?

- 4. Defer Often Read Ephesian 5:21. How have you lived this out in your relationships?
- 5. Make and live out your committment.

How important is commitment to you? Why or why not?
