

Privacy Policy Timberlake Church

The Timberlake Church website (“Site”) is operated by Timberlake Christian Fellowship DBA Timberlake Church, a nonprofit organization. Timberlake Church respects your privacy and is committed to protecting the personal information that you provide to us. This statement explains our policies and practices regarding the use and disclosure of your personal information by Timberlake Church. Please note that Timberlake Church reviews and updates this Privacy Policy occasionally as needed without notice. Therefore, you should review this policy's terms periodically to ensure that you are aware of how Timberlake Church collects and uses personal information. By using our website, you consent to the collection and use of your personal information by Timberlake Church, as explained below.

1. Personal Information

You have complete control over your personal information. You can visit our website without providing us with any personal information. However, there are instances where we must have your personal information for us to grant you access to certain event registrations, volunteer signups, or secure member resources. This information may include registration data (your name, address, email address, phone number, title, etc.), information request data, and response data (“user Information”). When you receive your confirmation email or any email from the list server, you will be given instructions on removing yourself from the list.

We may collect personal information through:

- **Forms:** Including order forms, sign-up forms, and contact forms.
 - **Email:** Customer service inquiries, complaints, etc.
 - **Cookies:** Including on our website and Facebook Page.
 - **Lead Generation Ads:** Used for newsletter/marketing/blog signups, new member outreach, and ministry partnership outreach.
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2. Use of User Information

We intend to use such information to support your relationship with Timberlake Church by designing website content suitable for your needs and alerting you to new product and

service offerings as they become available. User Information may be retained by Timberlake Church to verify compliance with the agreement between Timberlake Church and you, to keep track of the domains from which people visit us, to create a user profile to better serve you, or to contact you either electronically or otherwise. If you decide that we should not use your personal User Information to contact you, please let us know, and we will not use that information for such purpose. However, please do not submit any User Information if you are under 13 years of age unless with parental consent. No mobile information will be shared with third parties or affiliates for marketing or promotional purposes.

3. Disclosure of User Information

Timberlake Church does not sell, trade, or transfer User Information to third parties. We may disclose User Information if: we have your consent; we need to share it to provide you with the products and/or services you requested; we respond to a court order; or you violate our Terms of Use. You may separately agree to provide your personal information to third parties that provide content for Timberlake Church offerings, to access and/or use their products and/or services. If you agree to provide such information to these third parties, then your personal information will be subject to their privacy policies.

4. Analytics and Advertising Cookies

We use Remarketing with Google Analytics, Google Display Network Impression Reporting, and Google Analytics Demographics and Interests Reporting to advertise online. Websites and third-party vendors, including Google, use first-party cookies (such as the Google Analytics cookie) and third-party cookies (such as the DoubleClick cookie) together to inform, optimize, and serve ads based on someone's past visits to a website. Our website also uses third-party vendors, including Google and third-party cookies (such as the DoubleClick cookie) together to report how your ad impressions, other uses of ad services, and interactions with these ad impressions and ad services are related to visits to our website. 5. Accuracy and Security

The accuracy and security of User Information are important to Timberlake Church. You may review and request updates to your User Information retained by contacting

Timberlake Church. If you contact us to correct your User Information, we will attempt to correct such inaccuracies in a timely manner. Timberlake Church is committed to taking reasonable steps to protect your information from unauthorized access and use. We have implemented appropriate physical, electronic, and managerial policies and procedures to secure your personal User Information and maintain accurate, complete, and current records.

6. Usernames and Passwords

Access to certain content on our website may be allowed under an agreement between you and Timberlake Church and will require a username and/or password. In some cases, failure to provide personal information may prevent you from accessing certain Timberlake Church website(s) containing confidential information, products, services, or promotional offers (“Timberlake Church Offerings”). By accessing and using our protected and secured website(s), you agree to maintain the confidentiality of the username and password you selected to access such site(s) and consent to our Terms of Use (<https://www.timberlakechurch.com/terms-of-use>).

7. Cookies

Timberlake Church uses “cookies,” which are small data files stored on your device to help us recognize repeat visits, improve your experience, and analyze website usage. Cookies may store information such as your preferences or login status, but only the information you provide yourself. Cookies cannot read data from your hard drive or access cookies set by other websites. Information stored in cookies may be encrypted for security. We do not store credit card numbers in cookies.

You can choose to disable cookies or set your browser to warn you before accepting cookies. Most features of our website will remain accessible even if you disable cookies, but some secure or personalized features may require cookies to function properly.

Our website uses cookies for analytics (via HubSpot and Google Tag Manager) and may use cookies for advertising and remarketing purposes.

8. Facebook Pixel Notice

Timberlake Church’s website uses the Facebook Pixel service provided by Facebook Inc. This tool helps us measure the effectiveness of our Facebook advertising and understand

user interactions with our site after clicking on a Facebook ad. Facebook Pixel allows us to improve our advertising and may enable us to show you relevant ads on Facebook and its partner sites.
